## Information for International Students

In order to maintain your legal immigration status and remain legally in the United States, you must be a full-time registered student at all times. If you require an F1 or J1 visa, it will be necessary for you to demonstrate that you have sufficient financial resources for your studies. Also, if you will be accompanied by dependents, you must provide evidence of sufficient financial resources to support them, as well as the full legal name, birth date, country of birth, and relationship of each person accompanying you.
