# **Doctoral Student Inter-Campus Travel Grant**

## **BEFORE YOU BEGIN**

The Weill Graduate School and Ithaca-based Graduate School offer a limited number of awards to doctoral students who wish to travel between NYC and Ithaca to advance their dissertation research. Awards care for a round-trip ticket on the Campus-to-Campus bus, valued at \$150.

#### Eligibility

- Recipients must be enrolled in a Cornell doctoral program in Ithaca, Cornell Tech, or Weill Graduate School.
- The purpose of the travel between campuses must directly relate to the student's dissertation research.
- Students are limited to no more than two (2) awards between July 1st and June 30th each year.


#### **Application Procedure**

- ♦ Applications must be approved and signed by the student's special committee chair / advisor.
- A one page summary of the research must be included with the application. It must provide an overview of the research project and explain the benefit of travel between campuses.
- Recipients will receive a an award code that can be used at the time of booking.

#### Deadlines\*

### Applications should be submitted 30 days in advance of the travel.

- Students will be notified via email if the request has been awarded. Because funds are limited not all requests may be approved.
- If the proposed travel is canceled or postponed the awarder must notify the Cornell-Ithaca Graduate School (gradschool@cornell.edu).
