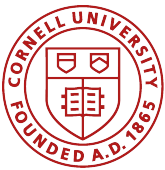
Program Change Process

Students may use this form to request enrollment in a different degree track offered by their current graduate field, or to seek a transfer to a different graduate field. In most cases, the field will conduct a review of your original application materials, letters of recommendations, and academic record prior to making a decision. If you are approved for a program change, the graduate field will provide you with an updated offer of admission letter. Any special terms or conditions, such as advanced academic standing based on time spent in your current program, will be described in your offer letter.

Information for International Students

In order to maintain your legal immigration status and remain legally in the United States, you must be a full-time registered student at all times. If you have questions regarding this requirement, please contact the International Students and Scholars Office (ISSO) in B50 Caldwell Hall. Contact information can be found at www.isso.cornell.edu.

If you require an F1 or J1 visa, it will be necessary for you to demonstrate that you have sufficient financial resources for your studies. Also, if you will be accompanied by dependents, you must provide evidence of sufficient financial resources to support them, as well as the full legal name, birth date, country of birth, and relationship of each person accompanying you.
